This week our attendance figure is 91%

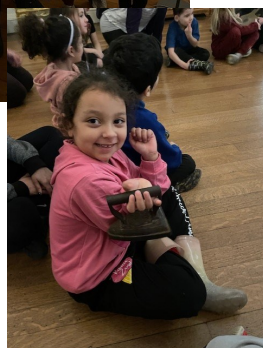
This week the number of late marks is 19
