This week the number of late marks is 27

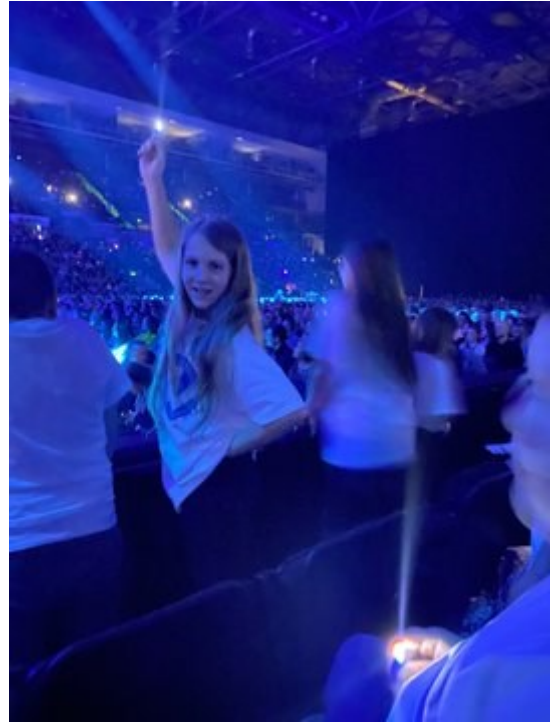
