Late marks have decreased significantly so THANK YOU! Remember, school starts at 8.45 am. Children are marked as late if they come to school after 8.55am.

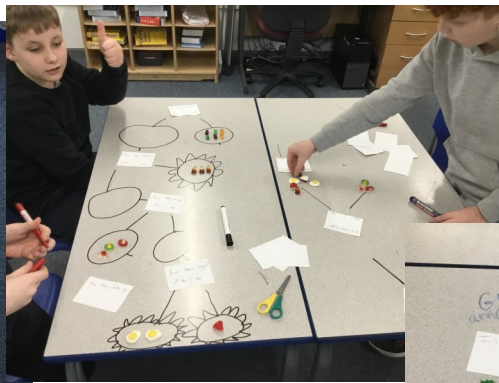
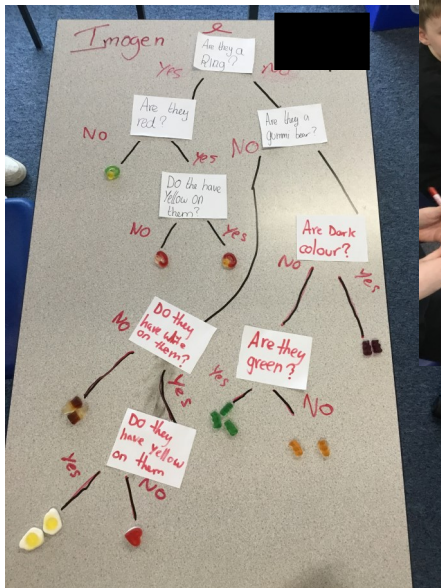
## RE Learning in Robins
