# Collaborative Learning Trust News

On 14th March, we held our latest Collaborative Learning Trust twilight training session for school staff - 'Reflecting through a SEND lens'. The event was a huge success, with over 100 staff from across the Trust attending. Feedback from staff was extremely positive – especially regarding the direct impact this important training will have on pupils across all our schools - primary and secondary.

The session explored what it was like to be a SEND pupil and the impact of educational approaches and expectations. The training was led by Angela Smith, who is Director of SEND for the Trust as well as founder of YCPD-Strategic SEND Leadership. Angela was joined by a guest speaker – a young person who has recent experience of education as a SEND pupil. Together they facilitated thoughtful discussion, and staff left with practical next steps to use the very next day in their classrooms.

## WOW

This week saw the launch of our Walk to School initiative. WOW is a pupil-led initiative, where children self-report how they get to school every day using the interactive WOW Travel Tracker. If they travel sustainably (walk, cycle, scoot or 'park and stride') at least once a week for a month, they get rewarded with a badge. It's that easy!
