



## Robins Reception Curriculum Information Autumn 2 2024

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Maths</b></p> <p>A deep understanding of numbers 1-6</p> <p>The concept of 1 more and 1 fewer/ less</p> <p>Addition and subtraction within 6. Remembering the pairs of numbers that make up other numbers, for example 5 is made of 3 and 2.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Reading</b></p> <p>Children will have either a wordless book or a book that has been closely matched to their phonics knowledge. Children will read wordless books until they can confidently blend.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Day 1: Decoding focus</p> <p>Day 2: Prosody focus (reading with expression, taking account of the punctuation)</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Day 3: Comprehension focus</p> <p>Books will be changed every week.</p> <p>Repeated reading is important to build fluency.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>Using 'Let's Celebrate' as a focus. ### Activities that we recommend your child does at home to help them to make good progress:

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Number blocks</b></p> <p>Number blocks is a fantastic Maths resources developed by Maths specialists to support children's early number development. We use this as a resource in school to introduce the different numerals. You can find various videos on YouTube and the CBeebies website.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Composition</b></p> <p>The composition of number is the understanding that a number can be made up of two smaller numbers. When we teach this concept to children we always say the largest number first so we would say "5 is made of 3 and 2".</p> <p>Save the Whale is a good game online game to practice this skill:</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Reading</b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Research shows that the most important thing you can do is read with your child.</b></p> <p>Your child will bring home two books from school...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Phonics book - Please help your child to succeed by listening to them read their phonics book every evening – even just a few minutes can make a big difference. Children who read at least 4 times a week, who have this recorded in their reading diary each time, receive a raffle ticket. If their raffle ticket is drawn in Friday's Celebration assembly, they choose a lovely book as a prize! Please ensure your child brings their book back to school <b>every Thursday to be changed, new books will be sent home on a Friday.</b></li> <li>2. Reading for pleasure book - Children will be given the opportunity to <i>choose</i> a book each week. This is to help promote a love of reading. It is unlikely to be in line with their phonics knowledge, so this book is for you to read and enjoy with them.
