World Book Day 2025 – A Magical Celebration of Reading!

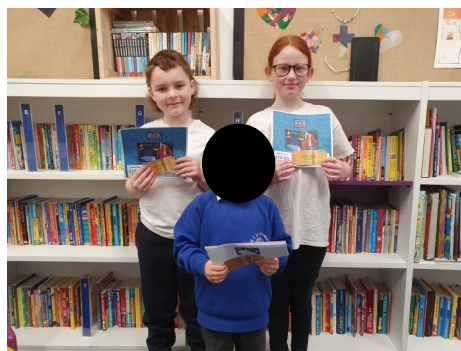
