Achieving this status is a reflection of the hard work and dedication of our entire team, who continue to ensure that every child feels heard, understood, and confident to express themselves.

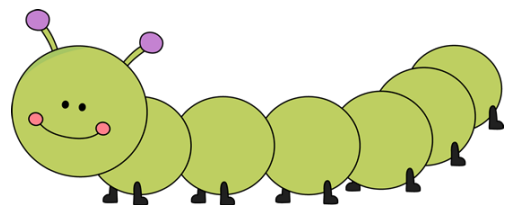
We're incredibly proud of this achievement and excited to continue building an environment where communication truly thrives.
