Falcons had an exciting day at Magna Science Adventure Centre, diving into the fascinating world of volcanoes and rocks! In our Volcanoes Workshop, pupils explored how volcanic eruptions create layers of rock and learned to identify common types of rock.

Using modelling clay, they built their own volcanoes and watched the classic vinegar-and-baking-soda eruption in action. Then came the real science—taking a core sample through their model and testing actual rock specimens. It was a hands-on experience that brought geology to life and sparked lots of curiosity!

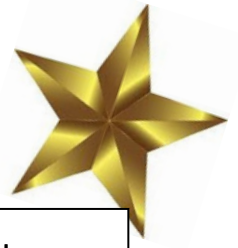
Reverend Wendy said:
