We are still seeing an increase in illnesses. We have continued to ensure additional cleaning has been put in place. Please continue to speak to your child about the importance of handwashing.

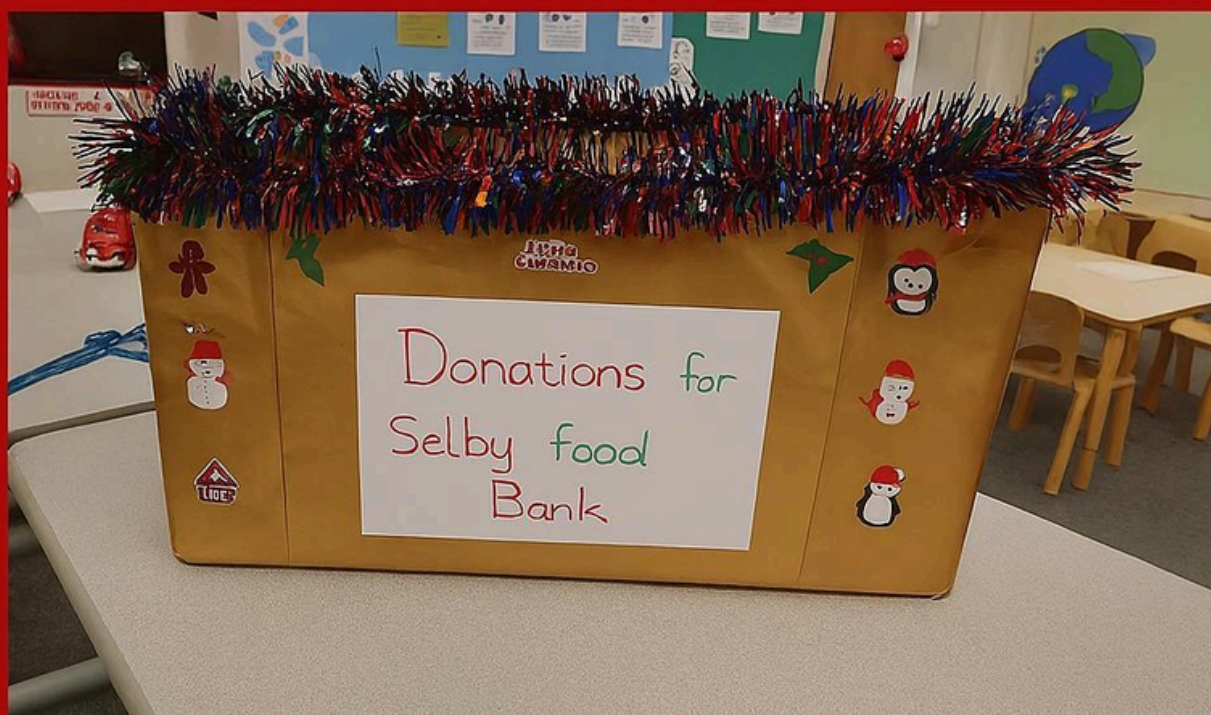
