We're grateful to Steve and his feathered friends for inspiring our young learners and sparking so much curiosity about the natural world. It was a visit we won't soon forget!

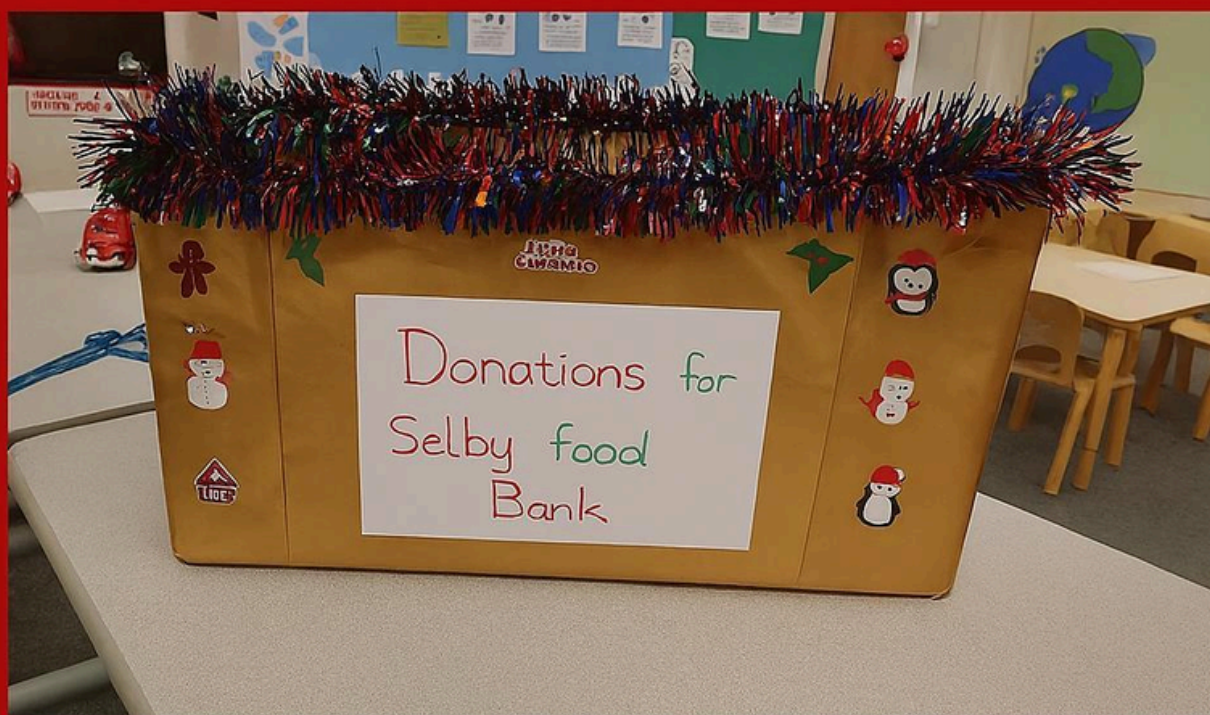
