Parking

Recently, we have noticed an increase in cars stopping on the yellow zig-zag lines outside school. These markings are there to ensure children have a clear and safe view when entering and leaving the site. Parking on or near the zig-zags, even for a moment, creates a real safety risk, and we kindly ask that all families keep these areas completely clear at all times.

We have also seen some cars entering the school car park when dropping off children. Please remember that the car park is for staff and authorised visitors only. To help keep everyone safe, we ask parents not to drive into the car park at any time.

Finally, we respectfully ask that all families use the footpath when walking to and from school. Walking across the car park—even if it seems quicker—can be dangerous due to moving vehicles. Using the designated path helps ensure a safe and calm start and end to the school day for everyone.

Thank you for your continued support in keeping our school community safe. We truly appreciate your cooperation and your care for all our children.

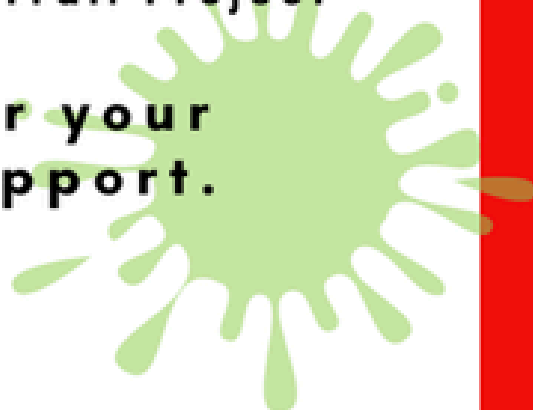
The Colour Box Raffle

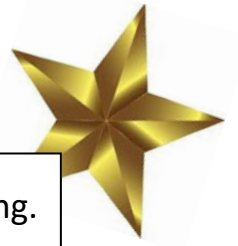
