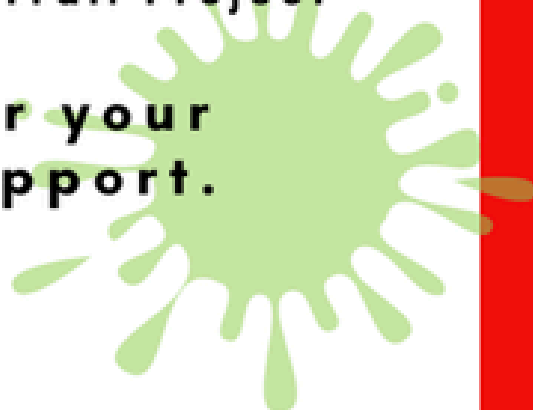
The Colour Box Raffle

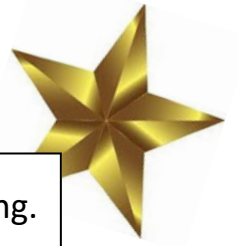


Colour Box
