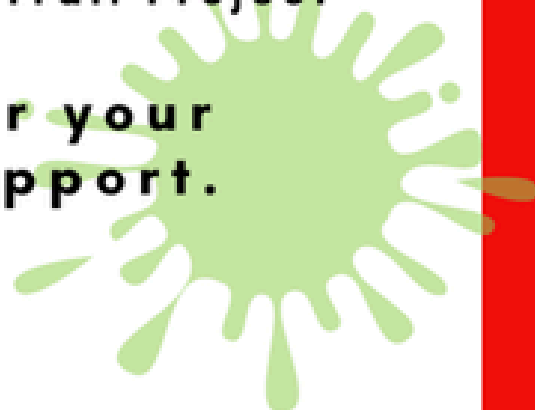
The Colour Box Raffle

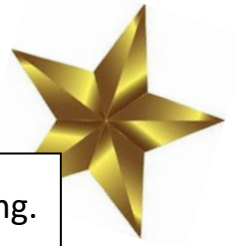
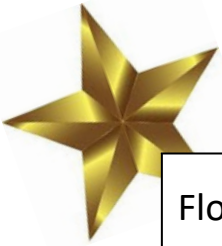


Lotherton Hall Visit
